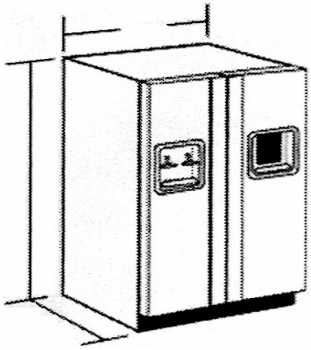

Fridge 33"W x 70"H x 33"D, Stove 30"W, Dishwasher 24"W, Sink 30"W, OTR Microwave 30"W.

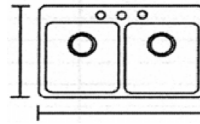

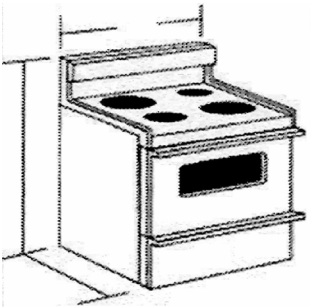

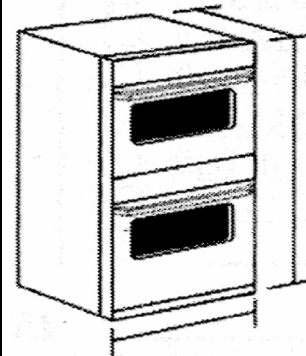
Single Oven

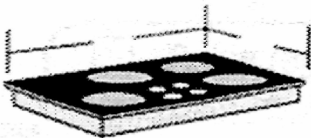

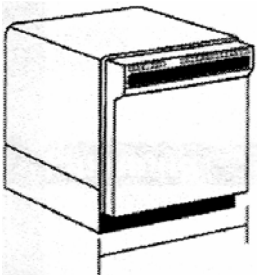

1. HOW TO MEASURE YOUR KITCHEN

To start, draw the shape of your kitchen on the grid paper provided. Each square represents 12 inches.
Note: All measurements must be in inches.

2. MEASURING WALLS

Measure all wall sections and note them on your floor plan.

3. MEASURING WINDOWS AND DOORS

Measure all windows and doors from outer trim and note them on your floor plan. *Note: Measurements should include height, width and distance from the floor.*

4. MEASURING THE CEILING HIGHT

Measure the height of your walls and note them on your floor plan.

5. MEASURING BULKHEADS

If your kitchen has a bulkhead measure the height and the depth and note this measurements on your floor plan.

6. MEASURING APPLIANCES

Measure the height, width and depth of all appliances and note them on your floor plan.

7. IDENTIFYING PLUMBING, GAS AND ELECTRICAL LINES

Measure from the nearest corner to the center of each pipe that currently exists or where you intend to place them. Mark this on your floor plan.

8. ADDITIONAL DETAILS

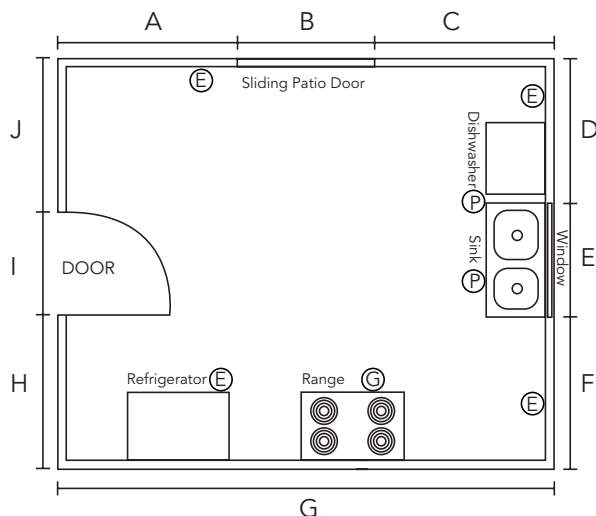
Please note anything that projects in room including radiators, pipes, ventilation, special angles and any other major architectural features. Include their measurements if possible.
